

Albert Park

City of Port Phillip

Albert Park is situated in the City of Port Phillip, Victoria, 3 kms South of the Melbourne CBD.

Famous for the Albert Park Lake, the park encompasses 2.25 square kilometres of parkland with a walking track around the lake and home to the Melbourne Grand Prix Circuit. It is bordered by Albert Road, Queens Road, Fitzroy Street and Canterbury Road. Surrounding suburbs include Albert Park, Middle Park, St Kilda, Melbourne and South Melbourne.

There are nine separate picnic areas, most with barbecues, shelters and toilets. There is a vast network of sealed and unsealed, shared pedestrian/bicycle paths, centered on a main route that circles the lake. There are several playgrounds of varying sizes; the park also hosts many large sporting facilities, including:

- Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre
- Lakeside Stadium
- Albert Park Public Golf Course and Golf Range
- Junction Oval - historic sporting ground.
- Several boating and sailing clubs
- Several rowing clubs at either ends of the lake
- Restaurants and Function Centres
- Various sporting grounds/ovals

Transportation in the area is easily accessible with many Trams available and easy access to the Melbourne CBD where you can catch buses and trains etc.

Albert Park is home to Yacht and Row Clubs, AFL Football Clubs, Netball and Tennis Clubs.
