

Chadstone City of Monash

Chadstone is a suburb in Melbourne, Victoria, 17kms from Melbourne CBD. Its local government area is the City of Monash.

Landmarks include the Waverley Basketball Centre, Jordanville Community Centre, Matthew Flinders Hotel and the very famous Chadstone Shopping Centre – one of the biggest Shopping Centre's in Australia.

Scotchmans Creek runs along Chadstone's Southern boundary, the Glen Waverley Railway Line runs along the Northern boundary, Warragul Road to the West and Huntingdale Road to the East. The Monash Freeway runs through the suburb. You can catch a train from Chadstone area and there are several Buss services in the area.

Sport;

Although Chadstone itself doesn't have too many local sporting teams the City of Monash does. If your looking for a local Tennis, Cricket, AFL or Netball team you will find one in the Monash area.

Education;

There used to be several schools in the Chadstone area – however some were closed and the land sold to Chadstone Shopping Centre to further develop.

There are now only two schools in Chadstone, both of which are Roman Catholic Independent schools. They are Salesian College and St Mary Magdalen's Primary School.

Monash University is also in the area for the mature students.
