Strathfield Burwood Council

Strathfield is a suburb in the Inner West of Sydney. It is located 14 kilometres West of the Sydney central business district and is the administrative centre of the Strathfield Local Government Area. A small section of the suburb North of the railway line sits in the local government area of the City of Canada Bay, while the area east of The Boulevard sits within the Burwood Council. North Strathfield and Strathfield South are separate suburbs, to the North and South respectively.

Strathfield is known as a regional centre for education and Strathfield railway station is a major transport hub. Strathfield town centre contains Strathfield Plaza shopping centre and a small strip of shops, restaurant and cafes.

Strathfield railway station is a major interchange on the Sydney Trains and NSW TrainLink networks and for buses serving the inner West. The M4 Western Motorway begins at Strathfield and heads West to Parramatta, Blacktown and Penrith. Parramatta Road links Strathfield East to Burwood and the Sydney CBD and West to Parramatta.
