

Blackburn City of Whitehorse

Blackburn is a suburb of Melbourne, Victoria, 17kms East of Melbourne's Central Business District. Its local government area is the City of Whitehorse.

The major shopping hub of Box Hill is only two train stops away from Blackburn, while three buses connect Blackburn to Forest Hill. It shares its postcode with Blackburn North and Blackburn South.

Blackburn enjoys three significant bushland parks: the Blackburn Lake Sanctuary, the Blackburn Creeklands park (comprising Blacks Walk, Kalang Park and Furness Park) which follows Gardiners Creek, and Cootamundra Walk.

Blackburn contains two railway stations, Laburnum and Blackburn, on the Belgrave and Lilydale lines. There are also several Bus Routes for the Blackburn residents.

Education;

There are five schools in Blackburn:
