Docklands is a suburb of Melbourne, Victoria, Australia, 2 km West of Melbourne's Central Business District. Its local government area is the City of Melbourne. Docklands occupies an area adjacent to the Melbourne CBD. It is bounded by Spencer Street, Wurundjeri Way and the Charles Grimes Bridge to the East, CityLink to the West and Lorimer Street across the Yarra to the south and is a primarily waterfront area centred on the banks of the Yarra River.

Docklands is home to several of Melbourne's modern landmarks, including Etihad Stadium, Southern Cross Station, Melbourne Star Ferris wheel and DFO Shopping Centre.

Docklands is forever developing and has become a very popular address for Business Headquarters and apartment living city lovers.

Docklands has access to road transport, rail transport and water transport. With the City on your door step you will find it very hard to ever get bored living in Docklands. Everything is a short walk or Tram ride away from Botanical Gardens and Museums to Shopping and Entertainment this location has it all.
