Glebe is an Inner Western suburb of Sydney. Glebe is located 3 km South-West of the Sydney central business district and is part of the local government area of the City of Sydney, in the Inner West region.

Glebe Point Road is the main road through the suburb, featuring a shopping strip, known for its specialty shops and cafés and for its variety of ethnic restaurants, possibly the most diverse in Sydney - Indian, Thai, Italian, Nepalese, Dutch-Indonesian, and other minority ethnic tastes. There is also Broadway Shopping Centre which was built on the landmark site of the former Grace Brothers department store. The shopping centre includes a food court and cinema complex.

Glebe has a popular market which is held on Saturdays in the grounds of Glebe Primary School. Arts, crafts, clothing and edibles are sold. They are known as the alternative markets for the alternative lifestyle goods that are offered. New and secondhand goods are sold there.
