

Malvern City of Stonnington

Malvern is an affluent suburb of Melbourne, Australia, 8 km South-East of Melbourne's Central Business District. Its local government area is the City of Stonnington. Its main shopping attractions are Malvern Central, home to high-end department store David Jones and Glenferrie Road, housing a wide variety of restaurants, shops and boutiques.

There are several beautiful Victorian parks and gardens in Malvern, including Malvern Gardens, in Spring Road.

Significant heritage buildings listed on the Victorian Heritage Register include Stonnington mansion (1890), Malvern tram depot, the former ES&A Bank (on the corner of Glenferrie Road and High Street) and the Malvern railway station.

The Malvern tram depot, located on Glenferrie Road, provides trams for the various routes which service Malvern.

Malvern Station is a busy station, on the Frankston, Pakenham and Cranbourne lines. In addition, Tooronga Station also services the northern section of the suburb, on the Glen Waverley line.
