Pascoe Vale is a suburb of Melbourne, Victoria, 10 kms North of Melbourne's Central Business District. Its local government area is the City of Moreland.

Pascoe Vale is known for its many parks and gardens, including Cole Reserve, Austin Reserve, Kelvin Thomson Reserve and Gavin Park. Managed by the City of Moreland, the Pascoe Vale Swimming Pool, on Prospect St, is a popular venue during Summer. There are many take-away stores scattered throughout the suburb, including pizza, fish and chips, Kebabs and Chinese, noodles and bakeries. The Moonee Ponds Creek Trail is used by cyclists for recreation and commuting.

There are a few pubs in Pascoe Vale; the RSL on Cumberland Road and the Pascoe Vale Hotel, on the corner of Railway Parade and Fawkner Road would be the most popular where they also hold trivia nights.

Public transportation is provided by Pascoe Vale Station, on the Craigieburn railway line and Tram Route 55.
